DENVER SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS	
Grant	<b>\$7,500</b> for businesses with up to \$100,000 in 2021 Revenue
Amounts	<b>\$15,000</b> for businesses with \$100,001 in 2021 Revenue (up to \$5 million in gross revenue)
Types of	Three types of grants are available. Businesses may only apply for one type.
Grants	<ul> <li>Stabilization Grants: for businesses that experienced revenue loss due to the pandemic</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Activation Grants: for businesses in targeted commercial corridors affected disproportionately by the pandemic (vacancies, service gaps, etc)</li> <li>Anti-Displacement Grants: for businesses adversely affected by publicly funded construction projects</li> </ul>
Stabilization	Must have been operational prior to March 2020
Grants	<ul> <li>Must be able to demonstrate a 10+% revenue decline over at least a 90-day period, pre-pandemic (2019) to current (2021 or 2022 for the same time period).</li> <li><i>Correct comparison:</i> Quarter 1 2019 with Quarter 1 2022. Other examples for correct comparison: Quarter 4 2019 with Quarter 4 2021; annual revenue 2019 with annual revenue 2021</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Incorrect comparison: Quarter 3 2019 with Quarter 1 2022.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Must be able to document revenue losses through a Profit &amp; Loss statements or a Sales Report (Point-of-Sale reports, sales tax reports, etc)</li> </ul>
Activation	Business must be located within, or intend to locate, within a quarter-mile radius
Grants	of the following intersections:
	<ul> <li>South Federal Boulevard &amp; West Alameda Avenue</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Colfax Avenue &amp; Broadway</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>East Colfax Avenue &amp; North Yosemite Street</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>East 47th Avenue &amp; North Peoria Street</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard &amp; North Holly Street</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>West 14th Avenue &amp; North Federal Boulevard</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>West Mississippi Avenue &amp; South Lipan Street</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>East Dartmouth Avenue &amp; South Havana Street</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Grant may be used to cover lease payments or investments in security</li> </ul>
Anti- Displacement Grants	• Business must demonstrate a 10% revenue decline comparing pre-construction revenue with during-construction revenue (using a 3- to 12-month comparison period)
	<ul> <li>Alternatively, businesses left with no choice but to relocate are eligible, although the new location must be within Denver and within a half-mile radius of the business's original location.</li> </ul>
